

Funding Criteria

- Eligible persons: members of federallyrecognized tribes, bands, groups
- Eligible sanitation facilities: drinking water, wastewater, and solid waste
 Community systems or individual facilities
- Eligible Cost: prorated based on the proportional usage of residential homes

Regular projects: existing homes

- Community systems, scattered sites
- Funded through the IHS Sanitation Deficiency System (SDS)


Housing projects: new or like-new homes

- Subdivision developments, scattered sites
- Funded through the Housing Priority System (HPS)


Special projects: feasibility studies, community buildings Limited funding

Emergency projects: actual or imminent public health problems Limited funding

Funding Amounts (Pending)

- ✤P.L. 117-58 Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act
 - ♦\$3.5B total for sanitation facilities
 - To be distributed in \$700M installments over 5 years, beginning in FY2022
 - FY2022 Spending Plan is pending approval
 - Distribution to the IHS Areas will follow
