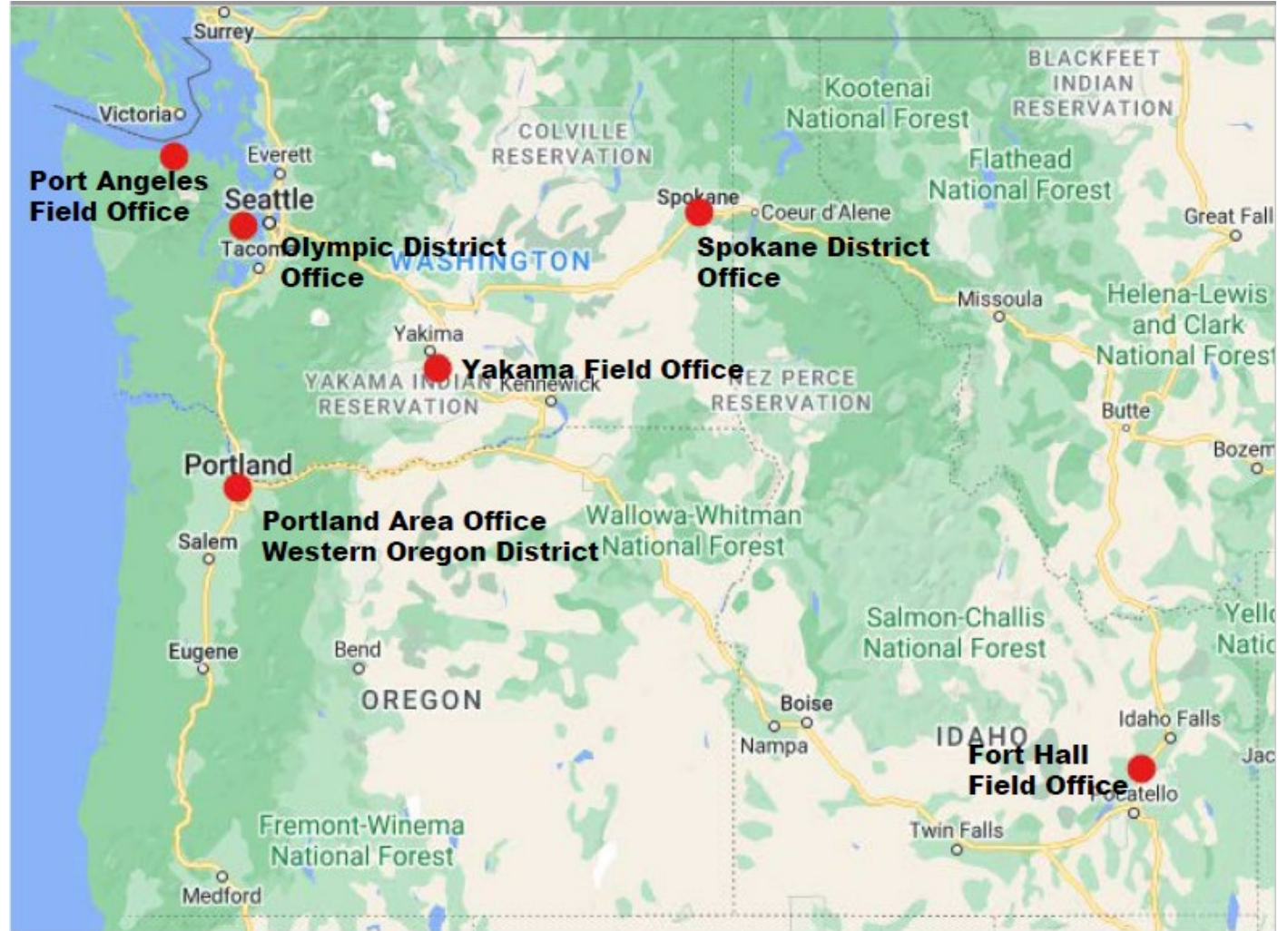

Funding Criteria

- ❖ Eligible persons: members of federally-recognized tribes, bands, groups
- ❖ Eligible sanitation facilities: drinking water, wastewater, and solid waste
 - ❖ Community systems or individual facilities
- ❖ Eligible Cost: prorated based on the proportional usage of residential homes

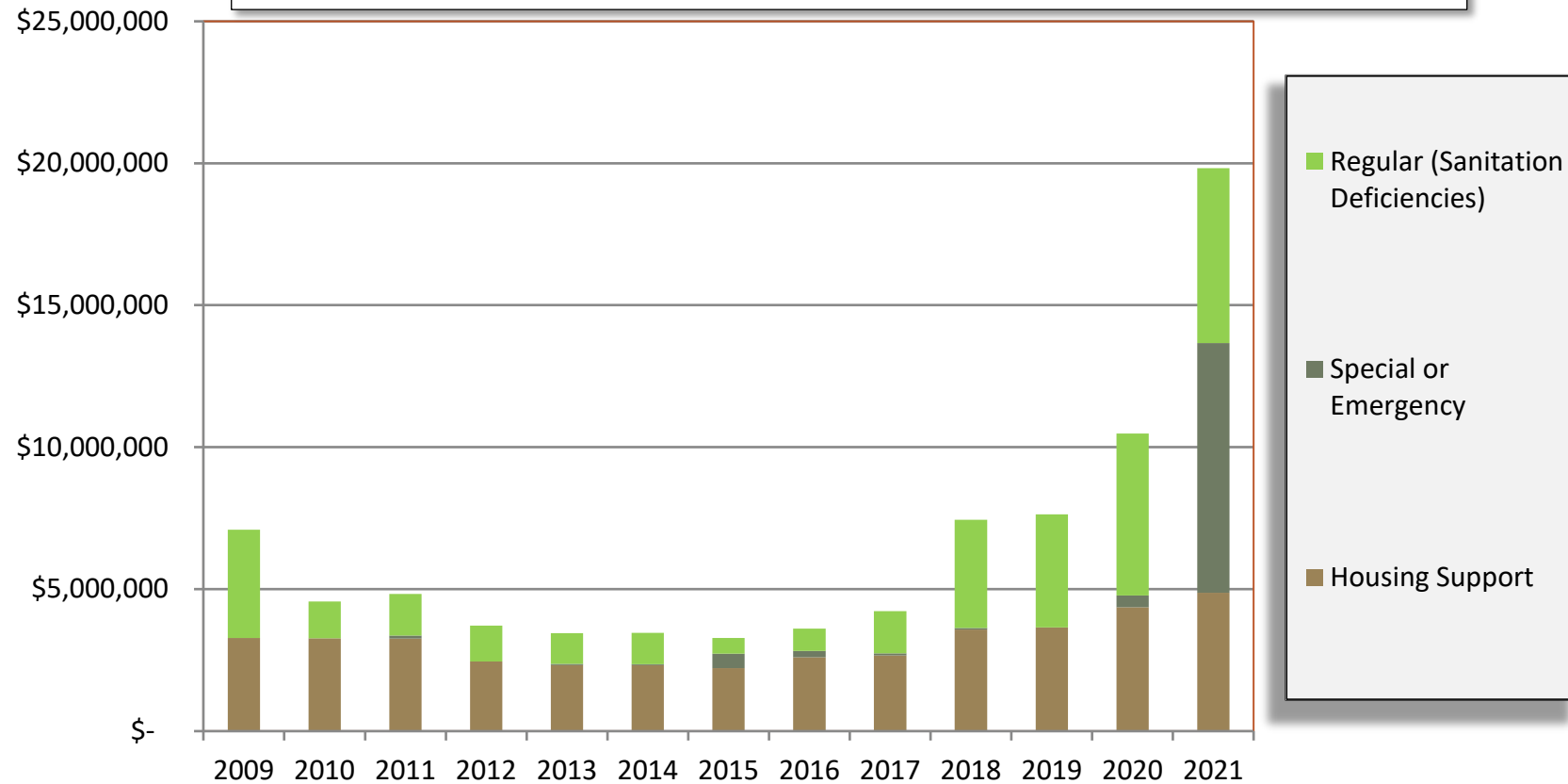

Funding Types

- ❖ **Regular projects: existing homes**
 - ❖ Community systems, scattered sites
 - ❖ Funded through the IHS Sanitation Deficiency System (SDS)
- ❖ **Housing projects: new or like-new homes**
 - ❖ Subdivision developments, scattered sites
 - ❖ Funded through the Housing Priority System (HPS)
- ❖ **Special projects: feasibility studies, community buildings**
 - ❖ Limited funding
- ❖ **Emergency projects: actual or imminent public health problems**
 - ❖ Limited funding

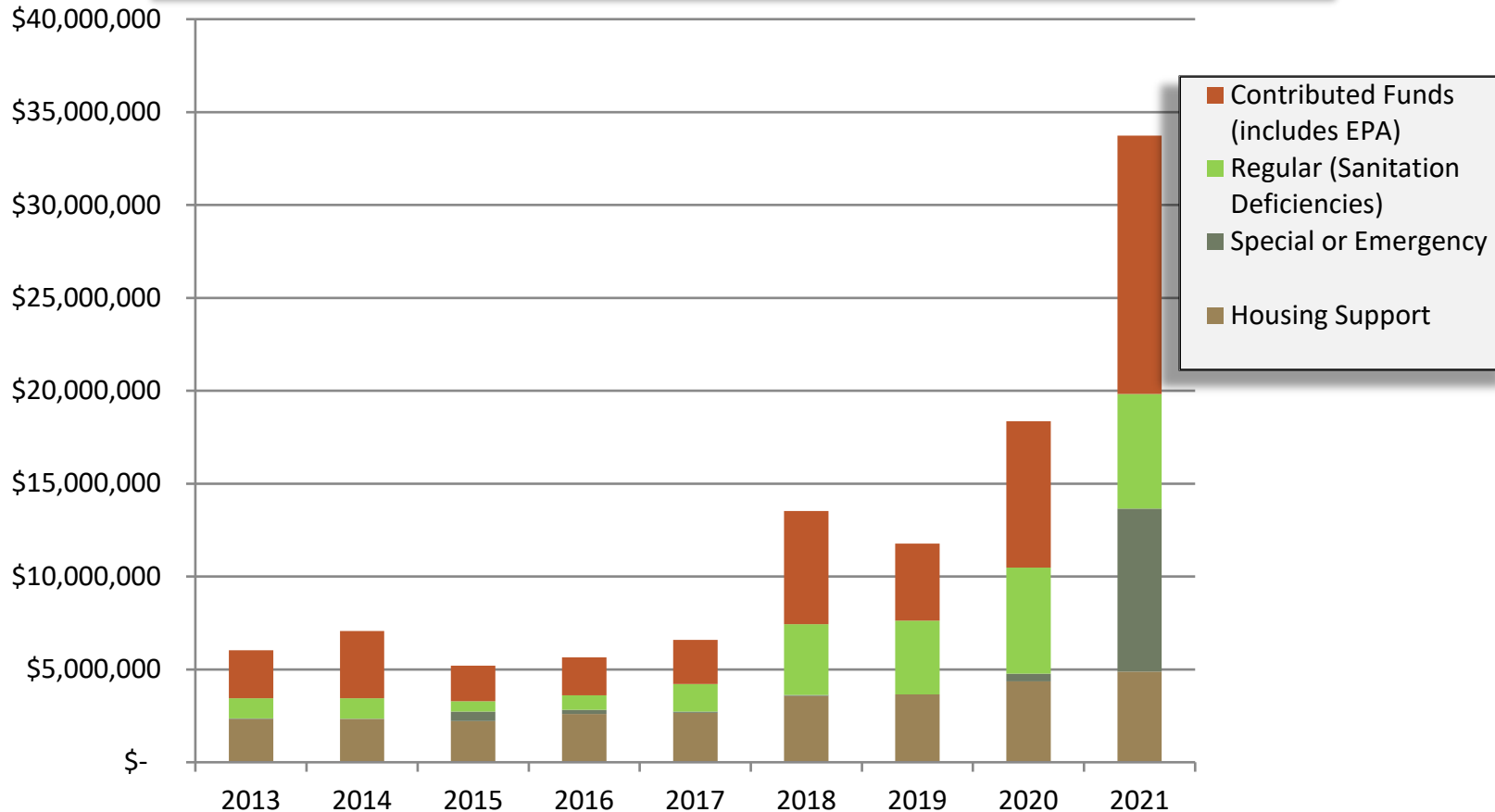

Funding Amounts (Pending)

- ❖ P.L. 117-58 Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act
 - ❖ \$3.5B total for sanitation facilities
 - ❖ To be distributed in \$700M installments over 5 years, beginning in FY2022
 - ❖ FY2022 Spending Plan is pending approval
 - ❖ Distribution to the IHS Areas will follow
